

THE OPENING OF THE CHURCH – SUNDAY 20th SEPTEMBER

It was resolved at the Church Council that we will work towards the opening of the Church for worship. It is hoped that our first service will be **Sunday, 20th September at 10.00 am with Rev. Martin Smithson as our preacher.** The service will include Holy Communion.

We shall follow the social distancing rules and government guidelines. This means that all attending must wear a face covering. Hand sanitiser will be available. The service will be adapted as there will be no singing and it will last no longer than 45 minutes. At the end of the service everyone will be asked to leave immediately.

We can accommodate up to 20 people. When you arrive we shall ask you for your name and telephone number (for track and trace), but this will only be retained for 3 weeks. You will be asked to fill up the seats from the front and when the service is over the back row will leave first. I am sorry that this sounds so regimented but it is so that we can follow all the guidelines.
