The Clerk will invite applicants to attend the next Parish Council meeting where councillors will select candidates during that meeting. The successful candidates will have the opportunity to join the council at the next Full Council meeting once their Declaration of Acceptance of Office and Register of Members' Interests have been received.

The Small Print!

To become a Parish Councillor, **you must:**

- Be a UK or commonwealth citizen, a citizen of the republic of Ireland, or a citizen of another Member State of the European Union;
- Be at least 18 years old.

To be eligible to join East Bridgford Parish Council, **you must;**

- Be an elector in the parish of East Bridgford, or;
- For the whole of the previous 12 months have occupied (as owner or tenant) land or other premises in East Bridgford parish, or;
- During the previous 12 months have worked in East Bridgford parish (as your principle or only place of work), or;
- For the whole of the previous 12 months lived in the parish of East Bridgford or within three miles of the parish boundary.

You don't have to be connected to a political party.

If you do become a Parish Councillor you will have to sign up to the Code of Conduct.
